We have tried really hard over the past year to shape our communication strategy according based on parents' access to apps and mobile technology. We ensure that all events are posted on our school website. Texts are sent out to notify parents of any letters sent home. You can access the events calendar on the school website and can download the app on your phone. We aim to provide enough notice for school trips and events. Sometimes opportunities crop up at the last minute, but we always aim to ensure parents know what is going on.
