### Your child's flu vaccination is now due.

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu.

There may be a rebound in flu levels this coming winter following low levels in the past 2 years as a result of COVID-19 restrictions.

#### Please submit consent here <u>https://www.cwpstartingwellimms.co.uk/Forms/Flu</u> by <u>12 NOON TUESDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER</u> to ensure that your child receives the vaccination.

It is important that you complete a consent form online before the deadline, otherwise your child will not be called for their vaccination.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had it last year, the type of flu can vary each winter so it is recommended to have the flu vaccine again this year or they won't be protected.

A leaflet containing information about the vaccination programme is attached to the email you will have received from school, and includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate.





Since the programme was introduced, most children offered the vaccine in schools have had the immunisation.

Members of the school aged immunisation service attending the school vaccination session will be wearing PPE in line with local guidance.
