



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'Next Steps' Instrumental Lesson Programme



Our 'Next Steps' scheme has been specially designed for pupils who have recently completed a whole class instrumental programme in school, to give them the opportunity to continue their instrumental learning journey.

Children signed up to the programme will receive:

A free individual 20-minute lesson with an instrument of their choice. (Ukuleles provided by school)

Free weekly access to an Edsential ensemble, including music theory classes.

Made possible through funding secured by Edsential from Arts Council England, this free programme is being offered exclusively to those schools taking part in a First Access project this term in order to initiate music tuition in school and would usually cost parents £145.

How parents apply:

- > Log on to the Edsential Music Portal: www.edsential.com/paritor (Parents may need to sign in or create an account)
- > Select the school's name, the child's instrument of choice, and the '20-minute individual lesson' option
- > Follow the registration process
- > Payment – parents **must tick 'remission' and select 'Next Steps Instrumental Lessons'** – this will ensure that the 100% lesson remission is applied to the cost of the lesson
- > Once checkout is complete, parents will be sent an email to confirm their successful registration.

It is our hope that 'Next Steps' will support as many young people as possible. But parents will need to hurry, spaces are very limited and will be offered on a first come, first served basis.
