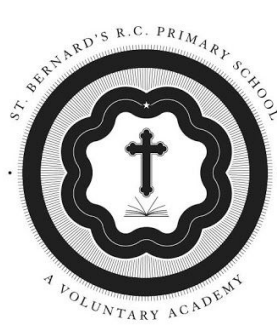

At St Bernard's we are really keen to get children fit and active. This year, we will continue celebrating whole school sport days, and focus on developing skills in new sports.
