Transition to The Whitby High School September 2021

Due to increased cases in Cheshire West we will continue with our half day Transition Days on **Wednesday 7**th **and Thursday 8**th **July**. In order to ensure that we complete these in a Covid safe way, we will be doing much of their experience outdoors, weather permitting and will obviously follow Covid guidance. We will aim to keep as many students as possible in their school bubbles but where students are from groups smaller than 10 we will have to combine and ensure students sanitise, etc.

This is part of our full transition offer detailed below:

- Each child will have half a day on-site to see the school and familiarise themselves with
- key staff and places.
- The Whitby" Premiere Event. A one-hour event hosted via Youtube going live at 6pm on
- · 06 July 2021.
- Every child with a parent or carer will have a virtual 1:1 meeting with the child's Form Tutor.
- Zoom meetings between Y6 students and Y7 students who attended the same Primary
- · school.
- · Cross phase work in a number of subjects including mathematics and science.
- The usual vulnerable children meetings with school, children and parents or carers.
- Two full day familiarisation sessions at the start of the autumn term in September.

In addition, as recommended by the Department for Education, The Whitby High School has put together a comprehensive Y6 recovery/intervention summer school with over 200 students already signed up. This will concentrate on English, Mathematics and Science with all teaching through our own staff who will be teaching the children from September. This recovery/intervention summer school will take place throughout the first week of the summer holiday.

Transition Visit Days

The Whitby Highschool will send this information in a letter next week to all parents and put it on their transition website and copy all schools into the email.

The morning Session A will be from 8.45am – 11.30am and the afternoon Session B will be 12.15 till 3.00pm.

Students should attend in their normal school uniform, bring a drink and a small snack with them. Students should have lunch before they arrive for the afternoon session. Children should brought/collected by parents. No child should arrive or depart on their own.
