Sensory Day Activities for SEND / Neurodiverse Young People

As part of *Once Upon a Time - Arts & Adventure Trail*, an artist with expertise in working with Special Schools and with children with disabilities will create a bespoke, accessible/sensory trail experience for children with SEND.

Using a drama and music-based approach, the artist and a support team will be your personal guides around the tour and help your child to interact with the trail, to bring it to life, bring it closer to you and bring you a lot of enjoyment. It will involve moving around various parts of the park for approximately 45 minutes.

Available support

There will be volunteer support workers available that allow for a ratio of 1 adult to every 4 children. Parents and carers are also very welcome to be their child's one to one support and come on the experience, OR, if you feel your child can be supported by us, parent and carers are

welcome to have 45 minutes respite on a nearby picnic blanket.

The car park is free and right next to the park. There are accessible, flat paths throughout the park.
