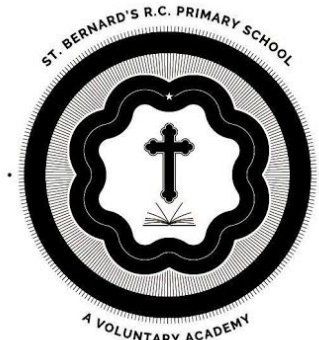

### **Team 6 update – 5.6.20**

Dear Team 6 children, parents and carers,

We have all missed you so much and wanted to let you know that we are on track to allow you to return to school on 15th June. We will hopefully be able to fully confirm this with you next week. We know it's been a long time since you have been in school and there may be lots of questions about what it will be like when you return. As mentioned in the video, if there are further questions you have or there is anything you'd like to discuss further with us, please let us know. **We are aiming to contact families individually early next week to seek confirmation that you will be returning.** We would love to see all T6 children back in school but the decision to allow your child to return is completely up to parents and carers.

Our key priority is the safety of everyone and we have put things in place in order for us to stay safe. We have a comprehensive risk assessment in action and staff will be on hand throughout the day to support children on their return. From our experience of more key worker children returning over the last few weeks, children very quickly adapt to the new environment and routines. We are here to support all children and families with this.

Due to safety guidance, we will have to split the children into 2 groups - one with Mr Brassington / Miss Tudor and the other with Miss Senior / Miss Foy. We will be able to organise these groups once we get confirmation of the numbers of children returning. You do need to understand that once your child is assigned a group or 'bubble', they will remain with this bubble and members of staff for the rest of term. Both groups will see each other at break / lunch times and although the children will be in different zones outside, we will set up opportunities for socially distant conversations so everyone can catch up with each other.

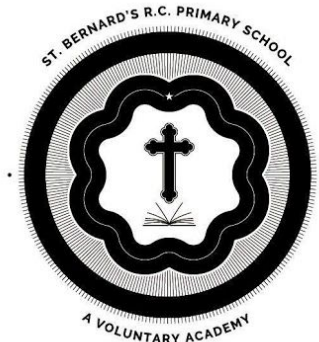
