

Attainment	
B	Your child's attainment is currently below the standard expected for their year group
WTS	Your child is working towards the expected standard for their year group
EXS	Your child is working at the expected standard for their year group
GDS	Your child is attaining greater depth objectives for their year group

Progress	
Grade 1	Your child is currently making less than expected progress from their starting point
Grade 2	Your child is making expected progress from their starting point
Grade 3	Your child is making more than expected progress from their starting point


